515.—Purchase Tax—Application to Sales of Clothing from Service Stocks to Pensioner Civilians, Shipkeepers, &c.

(V/E. 429/40.—29.1.1942.)

The issuing prices of any articles of uniform clothing taken up by pensioner civilians, shipkeepers, etc., who are required to wear uniform and receive a cash allowance towards its maintenance under A.F.Os. 2684/41 and 2785/41, are to be increased from the date of receipt of this order to allow for the incidence of purchase tax.

- 2. For the present the prices to be charged are as laid down in A.F.O. 514/42 for articles mentioned in that order. Application should be made to the Admiralty (Director of Victualling) for information as to the price of any article not included in that Order.
- 3. No increase in the allowances payable for the satisfactory maintenance of uniform can be permitted. The question of cessation of the cash allowances and the free issue of certain articles in lieu is under consideration.
