

2. Authorities concerned should check the Age and Service groups recorded on the Service Certificates of W.R.N.S. ratings where it is suspected that an error has been made.

## 5149.—Manpower—Re-allocation—Return to United Kingdom of Ratings in Certain Age and Service Groups

(C.W. 57646/45.—13 Sep. 1945.)

All ratings and other ranks R.M., excluding W.R.N.S., who are in Age and Service groups Nos. 26 to 28 inclusive and who are serving in ships and establishments abroad, excluding N.W. Europe, are to be returned to depots at home after relief, if necessary, in accordance with B.R. 1281 (1), Release Instructions.

2. Endeavour is to be made for these ratings to reach the United Kingdom between 6th November and 31st December, 1945.

3. With reference to A.F.O. 4685/45, paragraphs 1 and 2, the return of ratings in Age and Service groups earlier than 26 should be accelerated, when practicable, so that they reach the United Kingdom before 5th November, 1945.

4. All ratings and other ranks R.M. excluding W.R.N.S., who are in Age and Service groups 23 to 25 inclusive and who are serving ashore in N.W. Europe outside the United Kingdom are to be returned to depots at home, reliefs being demanded only where absolutely essential. Endeavour is to be made for these ratings to reach the United Kingdom before 5th November, 1945.

**5150.—Manpower—Re-allocation—Instructions for Release and Dispersal—  
T.124 and Variants (including the Commissioned Cable Ship Agreement)**

(C.W. 35210/45.—13 Sep. 3945.)

Section T.124/XV with Appendices F and G of the Instructions for Release and Dispersal are promulgated herewith.

2. The paragraphs of this section follow serially and should be read in conjunction with Sections T.124/I to T.124/V (A.F.O. 2653/45), Sections T.124/VI to T.124/XII (A.F.O. 2975/45), Section T.124/XIII (A.F.O. 3121/45), and Section T.124/XIV (A.F.O. 3733/45).

**SECTION T. 124/XV—REPATRIATION OF INDIVIDUALS NORMALLY RESIDENT  
OUTSIDE THE UNITED KINGDOM**

**PART I**

*Entitlement and Conditions*

181. An officer or rating who was domiciled or ordinarily resident abroad and signed his present Agreement outside the United Kingdom is entitled, subject to satisfactory service, to retention on his Agreement until he has been repatriated to the port at which he signed the Agreement.

182. An officer or rating who was domiciled or ordinarily resident abroad and who, prior to signing his present Agreement, signed any other of the Agreements covered by these instructions outside the United Kingdom is entitled, subject to continuity of service, to retention on his Agreement until he has been repatriated to the port at which he originally signed, provided that his service has been satisfactory.

183. An officer or rating who was domiciled or ordinarily resident abroad but signed his present Agreement in the United Kingdom and has no claim to repatriation on pay under the conditions laid down in paragraph 182 will be released in the United Kingdom in the normal way, and his pay and allowances will cease at the end of his release leave. He will, however, be entitled to repatriation at public expense to the country in which he normally resided if either of the following conditions is fulfilled:—

- (a) If he proceeded to and arrived in the United Kingdom on or after 1st September, 1938, or
- (b) If he proceeded to the United Kingdom for the purpose of attending a recognised educational or training course (including an apprenticeship), the period of which did not exceed four years, which was not completed prior to 1st September, 1938, and joined the Naval Service in the United Kingdom, irrespective of the date of his arrival.

*Note.*—The expression "ordinarily resident abroad" applies to any person whose sole or principal home residence is outside the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (including the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man) or Eire, being the place in which he habitually spent his time and lived, subject to demands of business or profession and periods of holiday.

184. Entitlement does not extend to individuals normally resident in the United Kingdom, who desire to emigrate. Such cases will be governed by the post-war policy of H.M. Government in regard to emigration generally.

185. Individuals entitled to repatriation who are serving abroad will have the option of—

- (i) repatriation to the country in which they were ordinarily resident;
- (ii) a substituted passage to another country overseas under the conditions laid down in paragraph 187; or
- (iii) return to the United Kingdom.

Passage granted at public expense under any one of these options is final and will completely exhaust all entitlement to repatriation. Officers and ratings are to be warned that the passage they accept, whether to the United Kingdom as above or as the result of a successful application for repatriation or substituted passage elsewhere, is a final choice and that they will have no further claim to passage at the public expense. A signed undertaking to this effect is to be obtained from all individuals who elect to return to the United Kingdom for release under the normal dispersal procedure.

186. Individuals entitled to repatriation who are serving abroad will be repatriated direct from where they are serving whenever practicable. Where repatriation necessarily involves a journey via the United Kingdom, they will be repatriated from the United Kingdom.

*Substituted Passage*

187. An individual entitled to repatriation who wishes to proceed to a country other than that to which he is entitled to be repatriated may, at the discretion of the Admiralty, be granted a passage to the country of his choice provided he complies with the emigration regulations in force and fulfils the conditions contained therein. In all such cases permission to enter the country selected must be obtained by the individual, who must produce a certificate of acceptance, bearing the signature and stamp of the accredited representative of the country concerned, within six months of the date of making his claim (*see* paragraphs 190 and 218).

*Release*

188. No individual will be entitled to repatriation until his release in Class A, or on compassionate grounds, or his discharge from the Service has been ordered (*see also* paragraph 32 (iv)).

189. An individual whose repatriation has been approved under paragraph 181 or 182 will be granted leave, as laid down in paragraph 230, starting on the day of arrival at the port of disembarkation for the country to which he is being repatriated. He will be discharged on the last day of that leave and will not be subject to recall. An individual, whose repatriation has been approved under paragraph 183, will be dispersed in the United Kingdom by the depot in the ordinary way. The date of dispersal will be deferred until his passage is arranged and his release leave calculated as if it commenced on the date upon which he is ordered to report at the port of embarkation.

*Claims*

190. Every officer or rating who desires repatriation to the country in which he is normally resident, or a substituted passage elsewhere, is to make a claim, if serving at home, as soon as his release or discharge from service has been ordered, or, if serving abroad, as soon as the order referred to in paragraphs 22 and 23 for his return to the United Kingdom has been received. In the case of an officer or a rating who has been invalided, the claim is to be made at the time of the final survey. An officer or rating who has applied for postponement of release and been accepted for further service is to make a claim as soon as his release is eventually ordered; if he is not accepted for further service, he is to make a claim as soon as his application for postponement of release has been rejected. Claims made subsequently will only be entertained in the most exceptional circumstances, and, except as provided for in paragraphs 191 and 193, all entitlement to repatriation at public expense will lapse as soon as the individual has been released. Claims are to be made on the established form of application in accordance with the directions in paragraphs 208 and 209. An officer or rating claiming repatriation who desires to attend a course of training sponsored by the Ministry of Labour and National Service is to make application accordingly at the same time as his application for repatriation is made. Particulars of these courses and the necessary instructions will be promulgated later.

*Deferred Repatriation*

191. In certain cases in which repatriation is not immediately possible through causes beyond the control of the individual (e.g. the continued occupation of the country by the enemy), he will be asked whether he wishes to remain in the Service until his repatriation becomes possible, or to be released in his turn in the normal way, retaining a deferred right to repatriation at public expense to be exercised when conditions in the country to which he desired to go no longer render his return impossible. The competent authority for granting or withholding the right to deferment of repatriation under this paragraph will be the Repatriation Office, London (*see* paragraph 216), in the case of applicants dealt with by that office, and the Commander-in-Chief concerned in the case of applicants serving abroad who are being repatriated direct. The grant of the right to deferred repatriation will be subject to its being exercised as soon as a passage to the country concerned is offered by the repatriating authority.

192. An individual whose entitlement to repatriation is under paragraph 181 or 182, but who elects to be released in the normal way, with a deferred right to



repatriation, will be in the same position as any other released person. His pay and allowances will cease at the end of his release leave and he will be entitled to no further benefits other than those specified in paragraph 203.

193. Individuals entitled to repatriation who are eligible for, and desire to take advantage of, the courses of training sponsored by the Ministry of Labour and National Service, are to be granted leave without pay for the period of the course. On completion of the course they are to return to depot to await repatriation.

194. Deferred repatriation will not be allowed on any ground other than those laid down in paragraphs 191 and 193.

#### Dependants

195. Dependants, as defined below, of individuals referred to in paragraphs 181, 182 and 183, will also be entitled to repatriation provided they were dependent upon the individual concerned at any time during the period of his service :—

(i) Wife.

(ii) Legitimate, legitimated, and statutorily adopted children and step-children who are dependant upon the officer or rating.

*Note.*—In this connection a child is deemed to be dependent if under 18 years of age in the case of a male, and if unmarried in the case of a female.

(iii) Unmarried dependant living as a wife, and dependent children under her care, who have been in receipt of an allotment, provided in either case that repatriation cannot be claimed both for a wife and an unmarried wife.

(iv) Persons not covered by the above who are dependant wholly or substantially upon the individual, for whom he intends to provide a home with him overseas, and in whose cases he can establish that considerable hardship would result if free passage were not granted.

196. Any person who is entitled to claim repatriation both in his or her own right and as a dependant of another (e.g. a member of the W.R.N.S. who is married to an officer or rating) may be repatriated under whichever title he or she prefers, but the provision of passage under one title will exhaust entitlement to passage under the other.

197. Claims for the free passage of dependants are to be made by officers and ratings concerned at the same time as they claim their own repatriation, except that in the case of dependants acquired since a claim for repatriation was made, the claims for their passage should be made as soon as they become entitled.

198. Whenever possible passage for dependants will be arranged in the same ship or convoy as that in which the claimant is travelling, but in no case will dependants be required to precede the claimant without the latter's consent. Dependants who are resident at such a distance from the claimant that their passage with him is not practicable will be repatriated separately.

#### Dependants of Deceased Persons

199. Dependants, as defined in paragraph 195 of individuals who have been killed or who have died while in the service will have the same entitlement to repatriation as they would have had if the individual concerned were still alive; or will be entitled, if appropriate, to repatriation to their own normal place of residence abroad, even though the deceased individual, had he lived, would have had no claim to repatriation in his own right, provided they embarked from the country in which they normally resided during the lifetime of the individual concerned.

200. Applications from the persons referred to in paragraph 199 will be called for by public announcement. Naval authorities who receive any such applications are to forward them to the appropriate Admiralty department, if at home, or to the Commander-in-Chief, if abroad, and advise the senders accordingly.

#### Permission to Enter the Country

201. In all cases repatriation is subject to prior approval by the Government of the country to which the individual wishes to proceed. All necessary entry permits, passports and visas required to enable the individual and his dependants to enter and take up residence in the country desired, and, if applicable, to carry on a trade or profession or take up employment there, must be obtained before any passage can be provided (see paragraph 218).

202. All necessary expenditure (including the cost of photographs) payable in connection with the issue of passports, visas and entry permits will be chargeable to public funds.

#### Conveyance

203. Individuals whose repatriation has been approved will be entitled to the following :—

(i) Rail conveyance to port of embarkation.

(ii) Ocean passage with free messing, except in the case of officers' families liable for messing contributions from whom messing charged at the appropriate rate, for the estimated duration of the voyage will be recovered before embarkation.

(iii) Conveyance by rail or water from port of disembarkation to the nearest point to final destination which can be reached by such means, including conveyance of baggage on the scale laid down in (v) below.

(iv) Accommodation and subsistence in kind, appropriate to the rank or rating of the individual, for the officer or rating and his dependants, for periods during which they are necessarily detained at ports of transshipment en route.

(v) Conveyance by sea and rail or water of baggage, up to the weights shown in the table below (inclusive of the quantities carried free by the railway or shipping companies) :—

No refund will be made of any charges incurred privately in connection with the conveyance of baggage. Except as provided by A.F.O. 6813/44, the Admiralty will accept no responsibility or liability for loss of, or damage to, baggage or property in transit, and individuals desiring to protect themselves against such loss or damage should do so by private insurance.

(vi) Subsistence allowance for the officer or rating only in respect of the rail journey from the port of disembarkation at the following rates, provided the entitlement to repatriation is under paragraph 181 or 182.

Officers ...	16s. per day.
Ratings ...	10s. per day

204. The class of accommodation will be appropriate to the rank or rating of the individual concerned, but if it is not possible to provide the appropriate grade of accommodation, the best alternative must be accepted. Similarly, the class of accommodation provided for a wife or dependant will be that appropriate to the rank or rating of the individual in respect of whom the entitlement to repatriation lies.

205. A rating husband who is being repatriated in company with an officer wife may travel in the same class as his wife provided the excess cost of the passage is paid before embarkation. Ratings availing themselves of this concession are not to wear uniform during the voyage.

206. Entitlement to repatriation is, in all cases, subject to acceptance of conveyance under Government arrangements. In no circumstances will a refund be made of expenses incurred privately.

#### Medical and Dental Treatment

207. Individuals who are repatriated will not be eligible for medical or dental treatment at the cost of Naval funds during passage and final leave in the country of their destination, since the facilities of the Naval medical service will not normally be available. Where such facilities do exist, however, an officer or rating may be treated free of charge by a Naval Medical Officer, or in a Naval hospital, during the period of passage and final leave.

#### Application Forms.

208. Claims for repatriation or substituted passage, and for passage for dependants, by officers and ratings serving at home are to be made in duplicate on Form S.1598. One copy of the form is to be sent to the appropriate Admiralty department and not as directed on the form; the other copy is to be sent to the Commanding



Officer of the depot. The appropriate Admiralty department is defined in the preamble to Section T.124/I promulgated in A.F.O. 2653/45, which also indicates the appropriate Depot.

209. Form S.1598 is also to be used for claims by officers and ratings serving abroad, and it is to be sent in duplicate to the Commander-in-Chief who will verify the entitlement of all persons to be repatriated direct and of such dependants as are resident on the Station. Should the Commander-in-Chief be in doubt regarding an individual's entitlement, one copy of the form is to be sent to the appropriate Admiralty department, by the quickest means, for verification, which will be communicated to the Commander-in-Chief by signal. In the case of persons to be repatriated via the United Kingdom, one copy of the form is to be sent to the appropriate Admiralty department and the other copy to the Commanding Officer of the Depot (*see* preamble to A.F.O. 2653/45). In the case of dependants who are not resident on the Station, one copy of the form is to be sent to the appropriate Admiralty department.

210. Commanding officers are to check each form of application from such information as is available on board. If the applicant is in possession of a passport, it is to be forwarded with the form of application.

#### *Rejected Claims*

211. Individuals whose applications for repatriation have been rejected are to be released in accordance with the normal dispersal procedure, those serving abroad being given the option of release on the Station on which they are serving under the conditions laid down in paragraphs 43 and 44 for the release abroad of persons normally resident in the United Kingdom.

#### *Cancellation of Claims*

212. Any applicant may cancel his application for repatriation at any time before orders have been received for his embarkation. In this event he is to be released in accordance with the normal dispersal procedure, and, except in the most exceptional circumstances, his entitlement to repatriation will lapse.

## PART 2

### *Repatriation from the United Kingdom*

213. All officers and ratings to be repatriated from the United Kingdom are to be discharged to their appropriate depots (*see* preamble to A.F.O. 2653/45) to await passage as soon as their forms of application have been sent to the appropriate Admiralty department. They are not to be discharged to the R.N. Barracks, Portsmouth.

214. All officers and ratings serving abroad whose repatriation or substituted passage necessarily involves a journey to the United Kingdom (*see* paragraph 186) are similarly to be discharged to their respective depots (*see* preamble to A.F.O. 2653/45).

#### *Leave while Awaiting Passage*

215. Repatriates who are awaiting instructions to embark may be granted leave at the discretion of the Commanding Officer of the depot in which they are awaiting passage.

#### *Repatriation Office*

216. All arrangements for repatriation from the United Kingdom will be made by the Repatriation Office of the War Office, which is staffed jointly by the Royal Navy, the Army and the Royal Air Force. The claims of members of all three services and their dependants will be dealt with by the Repatriation Office, to which all forms of application will be sent after verification by the appropriate Admiralty department. The appropriate Admiralty department will ensure that the type of Agreement on which the officer or rating is or has been serving is indicated on the Form S.1598 and will advise the appropriate depot of the date upon which the Admiralty copy is forwarded to the Repatriation Office.

217. Commanding Officers of the depots may communicate direct, as necessary, with the Repatriation Office, communications being addressed to:—

218. The Repatriation Office will take all necessary action to obtain entry permits, passports and visas of applicants for repatriation to the country in which they were normally resident, and will send the necessary forms of application to the Commanding Officer of the depot for completion by the applicant. The Repatriation Office will not, however, take this action in respect of applicants for a substituted passage until the certificate of acceptance referred to in paragraph 187 has been received.

#### *Discharge Books.*

219. Upon the receipt in depot of the Form S.1598, the Commanding Officer will advise the appropriate Superintendent, Mercantile Marine Office, who should be requested to obtain the Discharge Book from the Registrar General of Shipping and Seamen. On receipt of the book the Superintendent will endorse therein Naval service as detailed in the "A" copy of the Agreement. Where men are to be repatriated under conditions referred to in paragraphs 181 and 182 the Superintendent will make the final entry as follows:—

Date of final discharge.....days after date of disembarkation (.....). The Government Paying Agent at the port of disembarkation should insert the date of disembarkation in the Discharge Book (*see* paragraph 234).

Where men are to be repatriated under conditions referred to in paragraph 183, the Superintendent, Mercantile Marine Office, will record the date of dispersal as the day previous to the date of reporting at the port of embarkation (the latter date being the first day of release leave).

#### *Action to be taken on Approval of Application*

220. As soon as the necessary permission to enter the country concerned together with passport, visas, etc., has been obtained, the depot concerned will be informed by the Repatriation Office. The applicant is then to be ready to embark at short notice, and is to be warned that he is responsible for the arrival of his dependants at the port in sufficient time to embark with him, unless they are being repatriated separately in accordance with paragraph 198.

221. In the cases referred to in paragraph 191, where the application has been approved but immediate repatriation is impracticable, the Repatriation Office will inform the depot concerned accordingly. The applicant is then to be given the option of remaining in the service until his repatriation becomes possible, or of being released, in his turn, with a deferred right to repatriation. Should he elect to be released, he is to be dispersed in the normal way. The Repatriation Office is to be informed accordingly and furnished with the applicant's address on dispersal. The applicant is to be instructed to notify the Repatriation Office, without delay, of any subsequent change of address, and is to be informed that instructions regarding his eventual repatriation will be issued to him by the Repatriation Office direct.

#### *Medical Examination*

222. Repatriates are to be medically examined in accordance with the procedure laid down in Section T.124/VI and reports made on Forms M.51 and M.51A as directed.

#### *Claims for Disability Pension*

223. Repatriates, except those invalided, are to be issued with Form M.P.B.475 and the leaflet M.P.B.475/1 which, if they wish to submit a claim for a disability pension before embarking, they are to complete at once and despatch to the address shown on the form. The repatriate is to enter the address to which he wishes the result of the claim to be notified, and he is to be instructed to inform the Ministry of Pensions immediately of any change in that address, giving his full Service particulars and date of discharge. Payment of pension, if authorized, will be made through the Ministry's paying agents in the country to which the repatriate is proceeding.

#### *Civilian Clothing*

224. Officers and ratings are to be warned that uniform is not to be worn in a foreign country.

225. Additional clothing coupons to enable the individual to bring his wardrobe to an adequate level for civilian life will be sent by the Repatriation Office to the depot concerned.



226. A form of application for the issue of supplementary clothing coupons for civilians (Form R.H.389) will be sent by the Repatriation Office to the depot concerned for issue to repatriates for the use of their dependants, if required. This form is not to be returned to the Repatriation Office, but is to be submitted to the Board of Trade, 91 Victoria Street, London, S.W. 1.

227. The instructions regarding the recovery of uniform from ratings as laid down in A.F.O. 1848/40 are modified, and ratings who have completed three months' service on discharge are to be allowed to retain their Naval kit except the strictly uniform articles, viz. Naval buttons and badges including cap badges for men not dressed as seamen, blue jean collars, badges and cap ribbons for men dressed as seamen.

#### Embarkation

228. As soon as passage arrangements have been made, the Repatriation Office will inform the depot concerned of the port of embarkation and the date upon which the repatriate is to report there, giving as much notice as possible and indicating the anticipated duration of the voyage. The necessary passports, visas and embarkation cards for the repatriate and his dependants will be sent at the same time and the depot concerned will be informed of the Service representative, British Consular Officer, accredited British representative, or other authority at the port of embarkation to whom the repatriate is to be instructed to report immediately on arrival.

229. Railway warrants (D.N.A. Form 800) are to be issued to each repatriate in respect of the journey to the port of embarkation of himself and his dependants, together with baggage vouchers (D.N.A. Form 818) to cover the free conveyance of the quantities of baggage specified in paragraph 203. If the repatriate so desires, he may proceed to the port of embarkation via the place of residence in the United Kingdom of his dependants, in which case he is to be provided with the railway warrants and baggage vouchers necessary for this purpose.

#### Release Leave

230. All repatriates released in Class A, or discharged for reasons other than misconduct, are to be granted 56 days' resettlement leave and, in addition, overseas leave on the scale of one day for each month's service afloat or on shore outside the political boundaries of the country in which they were normally resident. The period of overseas leave to be granted is to be assessed from the individual's Service documents or other evidence available, and the information given in Item 18 of Form S.1598 (Application for Repatriation). The leave is to start on the date of disembarkation at the port for the country to which the individual is being repatriated, if his entitlement to repatriation is under the conditions laid down in paragraph 181 or 182. The release leave for an officer or rating when entitlement to repatriation is under paragraph 183 is to be calculated as if it commenced on the date upon which he is ordered to report at the port of embarkation.

#### Pay and Accounting Arrangements

231. Officers and ratings, whose entitlement to repatriation is under paragraph 181 or 182, are to be borne on the books of their depot until they disembark in the country to which they are being repatriated, and their pay and allowances are to be assessed as in Section T.124/XIII, paragraph 130, except that—

- (i) while awaiting passage, lodging allowance, under normal rules, may be paid if the individual cannot be accommodated in depot and is not sent on leave (see A.F.O. 5995/44 regarding messing arrangements).
- (ii) whilst on passage, provision allowance or leave allowance is not payable,
- (iii) whilst on passage, men on the old Cable Ship Agreement are not entitled under the terms of their Agreement to payment of Seafarers' War Risk Money. All other personnel are entitled to this money whilst on passage.

Note.—The pay of personnel repatriated under paragraph 183 is to be dealt with under Section XIII, except that if the final balance of pay is greater than the sum which can be taken out of the country under the currency restrictions, an appropriate advance only should be made and the balance dealt with under paragraph 234 (v).

232. As from the date of disembarkation, which is also the date of commencing re-settlement leave and overseas leave (see paragraph 230), pay and allowances are to be assessed in accordance with Section T.124/XIII, paragraph 130.

233. The account is to be opened on a special "Repatriation" Section of the Ledger, on separate lists for each category, and continued to the date of release.

234. The Pay Office Procedure laid down in Section T124/XIII, Part 3, applies generally subject to the modifications contained in the following paragraphs:—

- (i) National Health and Pensions Insurance charges are to cease on the Monday preceding the date of embarkation.
- (ii) In view of currency restrictions and of the fact that pay accounts of repatriates cannot be finally extended until the date of disembarkation is known, it is not practicable to settle up in full on leaving depot for passage. A repatriate is then, however, to be given an advance up to the net sum due to date of disembarkation.
- (iii) Army Forms X.303 (see Appendix F), in duplicate, showing to whom the repatriate is to report on disembarkation, will be forwarded by the Repatriation Office to the depot. (In the case of ships and bases abroad, this form should be reproduced locally if supplies cannot be obtained from the local Army authority.) The forms are to be completed and the original handed to the officer or rating for presentation to the Government Paying Agent at the port of disembarkation (see Appendix G) as the authority to the latter to pay an advance of approximately one month's net pay and provision allowance, or leave allowance, rounded up or down to the nearest £1. The duplicate is to be dealt with as indicated in (iv). Part III of the form is not applicable to Naval repatriates and will not be used.
- (iv) The date of the arrival of the repatriate at the port of disembarkation will be reported by the Paying Agent to the Repatriation Office (see paragraph 257 (iii)), who will transmit this information to the depot. On its receipt, the account of the repatriate is to be extended to the date of release. Should the amount advanced by the Paying Agent not agree with that authorized, enquiry should be made of the Repatriation Office. The advance is to be charged in the "Other Charges" column of the ledger, and the duplicate Army Form X.303 noted to show that this has been done, is to be forwarded to the Director of Navy Accounts (Branch 4 for officers and Branch 3 for ratings).
- (v) The amount of the final credit balance on the ledger is to be notified to the appropriate authority mentioned in Appendix G, together with details of full name, rank or rating, official number and the address to which the person is proceeding. The name of the authority notified and the date of notification should be indicated in the ledger against the final balance. No cash is to be remitted to the Paying Authority. On receipt from a naval paying authority of information that payment has been effected (see (vii)), the number and date of the Cash Account Voucher are to be noted in the ledger. An explanation of the amount authorized should be forwarded to the repatriate.
- (vi) It is the intention that the final payment to a repatriate should be made, as far as is practicable, by the end of the first month of his release leave. It is therefore desirable for the foregoing notification to be sent to the appropriate authority without delay by the quickest means, e.g. air mail or signal, if necessary.
- (vii) On receipt of the notification referred to in (v), any Naval authority concerned (see Appendix G) is to effect payment as speedily as possible. The amount of the payment is not to be treated as a transfer of cash, but is to be claimed in the paying authority's cash account. The number and date of the relevant cash voucher on which payment is effected are to be communicated to the depot concerned at home. The repatriate is not to be entered on the ledger of the paying authority.
- (viii) The attention of all repatriates is to be drawn to the normal procedure regarding the cessation of allotment payments laid down in paragraph 136 and their wishes regarding continuance of allotments after departure definitely ascertained.
- (ix) It is unnecessary to complete or issue Form S.1006 (Income Tax Certificate on Discharge).



*Unemployment and Health Insurance*

235. Forms U.I.3XS are to be sent to the Unemployment Insurance Record Office, Acton, London, as soon as the date of release is known.

236. Form S.1034 is to be completed in respect of each insurable officer and each rating, except those who have been entered abroad and are excluded from National Health Insurance during their period of service and disposed of as directed in paragraph 84. The date to be shown on the form is to be the date of embarkation and the form is to be endorsed "REPATRIATE". The address is to be that to which the repatriate is proceeding overseas.

*Certificates*

237. Each repatriate, whose entitlement is under paragraph 181 or 182, is to be furnished before embarkation with a Form S.1559, stating that he is on leave pending discharge and showing against "date of final discharge" the number of days' leave granted from date of disembarkation, thus: "Date of Final Discharge..... days after date of disembarkation." Each repatriate, whose entitlement is under paragraph 183, will be issued with the appropriate Order of Release or Discharge before leaving the depot to embark, but no form of application for National Registration Identity Card (S.1588A or S.1588B) will be issued.

*Reporting Release*

238. The release of officers and ratings, whose entitlement is under paragraph 181 or 182, is not to be reported on Forms S.161R, but as soon as advice of arrival at the port of disembarkation has been notified to the depot by the Repatriation Office, a return should be made out in triplicate showing the date of dispersal and the date of final discharge, and disposed of as follows. Two copies to be forwarded to the appropriate Admiralty department and the other to the Director of Navy Accounts (Branch 4 for officers and Branch 3 for ratings).

*Applicants Unfit to Travel*

239. If, after repatriation has been approved and while awaiting passage, the applicant or any dependant becomes medically unfit to travel, the Commanding Officer of the depot concerned is to inform the Repatriation Office immediately by telegram. The Repatriation Office will then postpone further action on the application until information has been received that the applicant or dependant is again fit to travel. If a passage has been allotted, the Repatriation office will arrange for the cancellation of the passage and for a re-allotment of accommodation in due course.

*Deferment of Embarkation*

240. Deferment of embarkation on any grounds other than medical will only be allowed in the most exceptional circumstances. Any application of this nature is to be forwarded to the Repatriation Office by the Commanding Officer of the depot concerned.

## PART 3

*Repatriation from Abroad*

241. The necessary arrangements for the repatriation of individuals serving abroad are to be made by the Commander-in-Chief, who should consult with local Army and Royal Air Force authorities and act in conjunction with them as required by local conditions. In this connection the following is an extract from the "Release Regulations for the Army, 1945":—

"In order to carry out direct repatriation, G.Os., C.-in-Cs., overseas will form Repatriation Offices within their Commands or make such local arrangements as they may consider necessary. It may be advantageous to form a Combined Repatriation Office in each Command to deal with claims on behalf of all three Fighting Services, but this will be subject to local conditions."

242. The necessary steps for furnishing the applicant with the forms of application for passport, etc., referred to in paragraph 218, should be taken on receipt of the application for repatriation (Form S.1598). These steps should not, however, be taken in the case of application for substituted passage until the certificate of acceptance required by paragraph 187 has been received.

243. When the applicant's claim to repatriation has been verified (see paragraph 209), he is to be repatriated as soon as authority has been received for his release, and his relief, if necessary, has joined.

244. Repatriation is to be effected in accordance with the instructions, where applicable, for repatriation from the United Kingdom.

245. Ratings who have completed three months' service on discharge will be allowed to retain their Naval kit, except the strictly uniform articles (see paragraph 227).

*Release Leave*

246. Officers and ratings are to be granted leave in accordance with paragraph 230.

*Deferred Repatriation.*

247. If repatriation is not possible on account of the reasons referred to in paragraph 191, the applicant is to be given the option of—

- (i) remaining in the Service until repatriation is possible;
- (ii) being released in the United Kingdom in the ordinary way with a deferred right of repatriation; or
- (iii) being released locally under the conditions laid down in paragraph 43, with deferred right of repatriation.

248. In all cases a report is to be made to the appropriate Admiralty department of the action taken. The Repatriation Office will be informed and will take all further action with regard to applicants remaining in the Service and those released in the United Kingdom. The Commander-in-Chief will be informed by the Repatriation Office when repatriation of applicants released locally can be effected. Action with regard to persons being released in the United Kingdom is to be taken as laid down in paragraph 221. With regard to applicants remaining in the Service, the Commander-in-Chief will be informed by the appropriate Admiralty department (on receipt of this information from the Repatriation Office) when repatriation of any applicants under his orders can be effected.

*Pay and Accounting Arrangements*

249. Entitlement to pay and allowances of individuals being repatriated direct without passing through the United Kingdom is as indicated in paragraphs 231 and 232.

250. Officers and ratings are to be discharged for dispersal to the most convenient local base, as decided by Commanders-in-Chief. The dispersal establishment will normally continue to carry the pay accounts until final release has been effected. The accounts should not be transferred to the books of the home depot if the repatriate is not passing through the United Kingdom.

251. Paragraphs 231 to 234 apply generally (local base being substituted for the home depot).

252. With reference to paragraph 234 (iv), the date of disembarkation and the amount advanced will be reported to the Repatriation Office, London, who will communicate this information to the Commander-in-Chief abroad.

253. As soon as the "A" copy of the Agreement has been received by the Registrar-General of Shipping and Seamen (see paragraph 257 (iv)), the Discharge Book will be completed and forwarded to the officer or rating at the address shown on the Form of Release on the "A" Copy of the Agreement (see paragraph iii).

*Repatriates Reporting on Disembarkation to Naval Authorities Abroad*

254. The rules governing the repatriation of members of the Royal Navy, the Army and the Royal Air Force and their dependants, are the same for all three Services, and have been communicated to British consuls and Dominion officials, who may be called upon to deal with repatriates on their arrival in countries in which none of the Services is represented.

255. A list of United Kingdom representatives abroad who, it is anticipated will be available when releases commence, is contained in Appendix G. Amendments and additions to this list will be communicated as necessary. Each service will use its own representative whenever this is possible, but at places where no Army or Royal Air Force administrative authorities are established, a Naval authority, if available, will be responsible for dealing with repatriated members



of the other two Services. Reciprocal arrangements have been made whereby Naval repatriates will similarly be dealt with by Army or Royal Air Force representatives.

256. Advice of sailing will be cabled by the Repatriation Office to the authority abroad to whom the repatriate has been instructed to report on disembarkation. A similar advice is to be sent by Commanders-in-Chief in the case of individuals repatriated direct.

257. The following action is to be taken by a Naval authority abroad to whom the repatriate reports on disembarkation :—

- (i) Arrangements are to be made for onward conveyance to the final destination in accordance with paragraph 203 and when applicable the subsistence allowance referred to in paragraph 203 (vi) being paid before the individual's departure.
- (ii) Each repatriate is to be paid an advance in local currency of the amount shown on Army Form X.303. Should the repatriate state that he has lost the Form, he is to be paid an advance not exceeding £10 to cover the period while further instructions are being obtained from the Repatriation Office by signal.
- (iii) The date of disembarkation, name and full service particulars of each repatriate, together with the country from which he embarked and the amount advanced to him in respect of Army Form X.303, are to be reported to the Repatriation Office by signal. The date of disembarkation and the names of dependants repatriated separately are to be reported similarly.
- (iv) Each repatriate whose entitlement has been under paragraph 181, 182 or 186, is to be signed off his agreement before a British Consul or Shipping Master at the port of disembarkation, and as soon as this has been done the agreement is to be despatched to the Registrar General of Shipping and Seamen, Llantrisant Road, Llandaff, Cardiff.

258. In cases where final settlement of a repatriate's account is being effected through a Naval authority abroad, action is to be taken in accordance with paragraph 234 (v) and (vii).

259. When communicating with the Repatriation Office by signal, messages are to be addressed "Admiralty (for Repatriation Office)"
