



When the replies to A.F.Os. 5316/45 and 5626/45 have been received, it will be known whether every officer in Age and Service groups Nos. 1 to 40 is a volunteer for postponement of release, or not.

2. In future, therefore, the only action necessary in respect of the release in Class A of each individual officer will be that of appointing him for Class A release, date to be reported. Notification of this appointment will be issued in the C.W. List of Appointments, and, if the officer is serving abroad, by signal.

3. When such notification is received in respect of an officer for whom a relief is *not* required, if he is serving at home, he is to be dispersed as soon as possible; if he is serving abroad, he is to be sent home as soon as possible for dispersal.

4. In future, therefore, signals will only be sent in respect of the release of officers serving abroad, and when an officer does not volunteer for postponement of release or is not accepted as a volunteer. Such signals will appoint the officer for Class A release, R.M. officers to their Headquarters Divisions, other officers to H.M.S. "President".

5. Pay documents of all officers (including W.R.N.S. officers), except R.M. officers and officers mentioned in B.R. 1281 (1), Release Instructions, paragraph 185 (ii), are to continue to be forwarded to the Admiralty (D.N.A. 4). See Release Instructions, paragraph 184 (iii).

6. No enquiries will henceforth be made as to whether a relief for an officer is required. Commanders-in-Chief abroad are requested to formulate their requirements for reliefs for officers, who have not volunteered or whose applications to volunteer have not been approved, and for whom reliefs are essential and cannot be provided from officer pools or from officers surplus as a result of station reductions.

7. To reduce signalling, only reliefs for officers holding specialist and important appointments, including Administrative W.R.N.S. officers, should be requested individually by Commanders-in-Chief abroad. Reliefs for other officers should be applied for in convenient numbers to meet requirements.

Action to be taken by Commanding Officers of Ships and Establishments at Home

8. On receipt of the C.W. List of Appointments notifying that an officer has been appointed for Class A release, date to be reported, Commanding Officers of ships and establishments at home are to take the following action.

9. *If no relief is required*, within one week of the receipt of the C.W. List, they are to report to the Admiralty (for C.W. I.) by signal the name and rank of the officer and the date on which he is being dispersed. This date should be as early as possible and not later than the latest dispersal date shown in the current release programme for officers, unless the officer is a volunteer to continue to serve under a temporary agreement where the establishment is due shortly to close down.

10. *If a relief is required*, on receipt of the C.W. List, Commanding Officers are to report to the Admiralty (for C.W. I.) by signal the name and rank of the officer and the period of turn-over required. The Admiralty will then appoint a relief for the officer and issue the dispersal date for the officer being relieved.

11. If an officer is no longer serving in the ship or establishment shown in the C.W. List, the Admiralty is to be informed by signal.

12. If Code letters and numbers are given against the name of an officer in the C.W. List, those letters and numbers are also to be used in the signals to the Admiralty referred to in paragraphs 9 to 11, and in any other signals or correspondence relating to his appointment for release. These signals are, where applicable, to be repeated to the Nominating Authority concerned, e.g. H.M.S. "Excellent" for Gunnery Officers, Gunners and Warrant Ordnance Officers.

13. Attention is drawn to the provisions of the Release Instructions, paragraph 77, with regard to the ships and establishments from which officers are to be dispersed. Officers can only be dispersed from the Admiralty who are serving in Admiralty appointments or in "not to join" appointments (Release Instructions, paragraph 87, last sentence), or have returned as passengers from abroad for release, or in special cases when definite instructions are given that dispersal is to be effected from the Admiralty.

Action to be taken by Commanding Officers of Ships and Establishments Abroad

14. On receipt of a signal as in paragraph 4 above, Commanding Officers are to report the name and rank of the officer and the date of his discharge from the ship or establishment to await passage to the United Kingdom. Where a relief has been appointed from station resources, the name and rank of the relief should be included in the signal.

15. Should the officer be no longer borne in the ship or establishment addressed, the Admiralty signal appointing the officer for Class A release is to be passed to the ship or establishment to which the officer has been discharged, and the signal is to be repeated to the Admiralty.

16. If Code letters and numbers are given against the name of an officer in the Admiralty signal, these letters and numbers are also to be used in the signals mentioned in paragraphs 14 and 15 and in any other signals or correspondence relating to his appointment for release.

17. The signals referred to in paragraph 14 do not take the place of the signals required by the Release Instructions, paragraph 84.

Requests for Reliefs

18. In order that officers requiring reliefs shall be dispersed by the latest dates shown in the current release programme for officers and bearing particularly in mind that the provision of a relief of equal seniority and experience may not be possible and consequently a period of training and understudying may in many cases be necessary, it will be essential for ships and authorities to plan ahead and request reliefs as far in advance as possible, where necessary anticipating the receipt of the signals or appointments referred to in paragraph 2 above.

Officers and ratings of the permanent R.N.V.R. were entered under a pledge contained in Article 165 of the R.N.V.R. Regulations that "the R.N.V.R. shall have as far as possible the first claim to be discharged on the termination of hostilities or as soon as any portion of the Reserve can be dispensed with".

2. The Government have decided that releases from the forces must be by Age and Service groups, which decision has been re-affirmed since the defeat of Japan. Unrestricted priority of release to the permanent R.N.V.R. officers and ratings cannot therefore be given at present but the matter will be reconsidered shortly in the light of progress made in effecting releases and the number of R.N.V.R. personnel remaining.

3. Their Lordships have therefore decided to grant to permanent R.N.V.R. officers and ratings all the preference which is admissible under the Re-allocation Plan. They are to be given priority of passage from abroad, when due to return to the United Kingdom preparatory to release. Similarly, ratings of the permanent R.N.V.R. serving at home are to be given priority of dispersal amongst the ratings whose release has been ordered. Action will be taken by the Admiralty in arranging priority of release of permanent R.N.V.R. officers in the groups which are being released.

4. This Order relates to :—

- (i) Permanent R.N.V.R. officers, including R.N.V.(W).R.
- (ii) Temporary R.N.V.R. officers promoted from R.N.V.R. or R.N.V.(W).R. ratings.
- (iii) R.N.V.R. ratings, including R.N.V.(W).R.

5. In order to facilitate this decision, messages asking for reliefs for such officers should draw attention to the fact that they come under the above description.

6049.—Manpower—Re-allocation—T.124X Officers—Volunteers for Postponement of Release—REPORTS

So far as is practicable, all T.124X engineer and supply officers will be released at the same rate as general service engineers and supply officers, as promulgated from time to time by Admiralty General Messages.
