Strengthen Technical engagement and communications

The Navy Engineering Community is focused on strengthening technical engagement and communication to promote collaboration, multi-directional communication, and feedback.

Benefits

- Increased collaboration will allow engineers and technicians the opportunity to exchange technical knowledge and ideas.
- Facilitate the sharing of best practices and promote the adoption of new standards and solutions.
- Provide multi-directional communication and feedback mechanism for the Navy Engineering Community (NEC).

Current Practices

- **ForceNet – Navy Engineering Community** – Provides primary communication to members of the NEC through regular posts on the ForceNet platform.
- **SharePoint – Naval Engineering Community – TechPort** – Is the ‘Home Page’ of the NEC providing a DPN hub for Sailors, Officers, and APS to readily access policy, guidance, and information supportive to member’s education, professional development and duties.
- **Naval Engineering Talks** – NET facilitates knowledge sharing and multi-directional communication through fortnightly presentations hosted on ADELE.

What’s Next

- **NEC Communications Hub** – Is being established by the Navy Engineering Branch (NEB), to provide a central location of services available to NEC members. Links include: professional development opportunities, health and wellbeing, education and training, and NEC stakeholder links.
- **NEC Fact Sheets** – NEC Fact Sheets will articulate the various undertakings associated with: professional development opportunities, recruitment and retention initiatives, education and training, and trades and qualifications.
